



# Saying likes and dislikes

In Indonesian, there are four words commonly used for saying likes/dislikes.

<b>suka sekali</b>	<b>really like</b>
<b>suka</b>	<b>like</b>
<b>tidak suka</b>	<b>don't like</b>
<b>benci</b>	<b>hate</b>

For example:

Saya suka sekali apel.	I really like apples.
Saya suka es krim.	I like ice cream.
Saya tidak suka kopi.	I don't like coffee.
Saya benci susu.	I hate milk.

To find out whether someone likes/dislikes something, we say:

Kamu suka nasi goreng?	Do you like fried rice?
Ya, saya suka nasi goreng.	Yes, I like fried rice.
Tidak, saya tidak suka nasi goreng.	No, I don't like fried rice.
